Opaskwayak Health Authority is seeking 1 qualified individual to fill the position of **Full-Time Behavioral Health Clinician – TERM (covering parental leave - starting October 2025)** in the Mental Wellness team.

Job Summary

Reporting to the RN ICT Coordinator, the Behavioral Health Clinician (BHC) is responsible for working with clients who self-refer or are referred to by a provider or health team member, to recognize and address mental wellness symptoms and conditions. The BHC is a key member of the JPCFI program, is assigned key responsibilities; practices organizational and cultural competencies to the highest level; supports program members by picking up tasks as required (within a defined scope) to ensure smooth and efficient performance of the program and provides scheduled coverage for other BHCs when required.

Position Requirements:

- Baccalaureate Degree social work, counselling or psychology
- Registration with the Manitoba College of Social Workers
- 2 years of experience in social work/counselling, case management, motivational interviewing and providing care to a First Nations population
- Valid Manitoba Class 5 Driver's License & daily access to a vehicle
- MS Office Word, Excel, Outlook, PowerPoint
- Satisfactory employment record including attendance at work
