Rod McGillivray Memorial Care Home is seeking one (1) qualified individual to fill the role of **FULL TIME PERMANENT Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN)**. This position is in scope under the Manitoba Nurses Union Local 150.

Job Summary

Reporting to the Nurse Unit Manager, the Licensed Practical Nurse provides professional practical nursing services to designated residents including independent nursing services, administration of prescribed medical treatments, collaboration and interaction within the health care team and participation in the coordination of resident care and discharge. May be responsible for directing students, health care aides and other support staff in the performance of resident care. Collaborates with physicians and professional health staff in the facility and the community. The LPN demonstrates a commitment to the Mission, Vision, Values, goals and objectives of the Rod McGillivray Memorial Care Home.

Position Requirements:

- Graduate of an approved Licensed Practical Nursing education program
- Active Registration with the College of Licensed Practical Nurses of Manitoba (required)
- Certificate – CPR or Basic Life Support (required)
- Transportation of Dangerous Goods (preferred or willing to obtain within 3 months)
- Safe Food Handling (preferred)
- Experience with chronic illness, geriatrics, and complex continuing care
